PREP

is a preventive treatment taken by HIV-negative individuals (people who do not have HIV) before a risky situation to prevent HIV infection. It is recommended for individuals who have repeated high-risk exposure to HIV through unprotected sexual intercourse.





THE DOSING PROTOCOL MAY VARY ACCORDING TO THE INDIVIDUAL'S **NEEDS AND IS DEFINED WITH THE** PRESCRIBING DOCTOR.





PREP is covered by the CNS, and medical consultations are also reimbursed by the CNS.

IN LUXEMBOURG, PREP IS AVAILABLE ONLY WITH A MEDICAL PRESCRIPTION FROM THE "SERVICE NATIONAL DES MALADIES INFECTIEUSES" OF THE CHL.


